

QUARRY ACCESS, ACTIVITIES & WATERCRAFT USE

Members MUST accompany their guests.

1.) No swimming is allowed. Trespassing on any private property (decks & boat docks) is not permitted.

2.) Homeowners who own property on the lake may swim at their risk within their designated property line (approximately 25 feet from the shore). If lake property owners utilize their boats within the common area, they must follow the same policies as Club boaters while they are off their own property.

3.) Paddleboat and Kayak reservations are accepted, but not necessary. Excursions are on a first-come, first-served basis. By signing below, you agree to the following rules while using a Club paddleboat or Kayak:

- You must provide and wear, at all times, a Coast Guard approved life vest before entering the dock and lake area.
- Only 3 people are allowed per boat. 2 adults and one child under 12 and/or 1 adult 2 children under 12 are permitted. 1 person per Kayak.
- No children under 18 may use the boats unless accompanied by a parent or guardian. All minors (under age 18) (must have specific signed authorization of their parents to use the boats on the lake when boating with other guardians.
- All Club boaters must check-in with the front desk and request access to the dock. Boats may be checked out for two hour time blocks and all boats must be returned at least 30 minutes before closing time.
- If you would like to fish, a nominal restocking fee will be charged to replace catfish not released (\$7.00 per pound or as posted). Catch and release of uninjured fish is encouraged.

- Remember that loud talking and other noise is amplified off the water. Please help maintain a quiet environment.
- Fishing is allowed from the lower clubhouse dock only, must be over 14 years old.
- For safety and to avoid trespassing on homeowners lots which extend into the water, boaters should venture no (closer than 25 feet to all lake shore or walls except in the docking area where they originated from. Club boats may not dock anywhere except the Clubhouse dock.
- Do not throw trash or cigarette butts into the water. Secure all trash and return to the dock depositor.
- Only boats belonging to the Club or to an owner whose lot projects into the lake are allowed. All boats must be certified as to capacity and shall not exceed 12 feet in length.
- By signing and dating below, I acknowledge that I have been granted use of a Paramount Club paddleboat and/or kayak and that I have read the above rules and agree to abide by them at all times. I also understand that failure to comply with the above rules could result in temporary, or in some cases permanent, restriction from Club paddleboats, kayaks and / or Clubhouse use.
- YOU MUST LEAVE YOUR DRIVER'S LICENSE AT THE FRONT DESK WHEN CHECKING OUT A WATER CRAFT
